

## PRESCHOOL LIBRARY INFORMATION



The preschool library is a wonderful place for your child to choose interesting books for you to read together. To make sure the library can benefit all our preschool children, here are some guidelines parents should follow:

- Each child should check out one (1) book at a time. This will help keep a variety of books on the shelves to choose from. It will also help parents keep track of which book their child has out.
- Make sure to keep the library book in a safe place so the book will not be damaged.
- Books should be returned on the child's library day. The books can be returned at any time, but no later than library day. Your child may not be able to check out a new book if the previous one is still out.
- When helping your child return library books, please make sure the books go in the tub marked for your child's class. This will help the library assistants do their job, and will cut down on lost books.
- If a book is accidentally damaged, you should do the following:
  - Notify the librarian or library assistant from your child's class
  - Return the book to preschool as soon as possible to be repaired
  - Replace the book with a similar one if the damages are severe.
